The aperitivo sets the stage. Although the name suggests whetting the appetite before a meal, today this Italian term also stands for a moment of indulgence—and a wide variety of drinks. Falstaff has tasted its way through the selection and singled out the best.

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Aperitivo - Non-Alcoholic

Martini Floreale
Martini, Pessione

Floral-herbal base notes on the nose, reminiscent of camomile and yellow fruit. The mouthfeel is pleasant, initially carried by freshness and a little sweetness, before the tartness of unsweetened black tea emerges in the finish.

Mionetto Aperitivo 0,0%
Mionetto, Valdobbiadene

0.5% ABV, Fresh on the nose with a typical rhubarb and bitter orange aroma, accompanied by tangy, greenish notes of zest. The taste constantly oscillates between clear sweetness and well-dosed bitterness, an exciting base for spritzing.

0.5% ABV, Quite a strong head when poured. The aroma of bitter orange is fruity. Tingling mouthfeel that gives a lot of freshness, citrusy acidity is present in the mouth for a long time. Long lasting.

Giffard Spritz Alkoholfrei
Giffard, Avriillé

Lots of freshness on the nose, especially pink grapefruit zest. Quite a full mouthfeel that benefits from a distinct sweetness at the beginning. A bitter note rises strongly from the middle and takes first place in the finish before a sweetish base.

Pallini Limonzero
Pallini S.p.A., Rom 1

0.5% ABV, Attractive, dark lemon yellow with a slight cloudiness. The nose brings a surge of zest - not only lemon, but also grapefruit comes to mind. Full-bodied and



dense aromas of rhubarb, bitter orange and tart juniper. Perfectly composed on the palate, sweetness and bitterness are close together. The finish gives the impression of olive brine. Molto bene.

20% ABV, Rich in the nose with elderflower and well-dosed citrus notes, plus a slight hint of lemongrass. Soft, tightly woven and well-balanced on the palate. These fine notes persist into the finish and the aftertaste with enormous length.

14.8% ABV, The very fragrant nose is reminiscent of freshly sliced Amalfi lemons and candied lemon peel. On the palate, a strong sweetness is noticeable, the citrus freshness becomes more subtle. Very refreshing with a strong sparkling soda.
